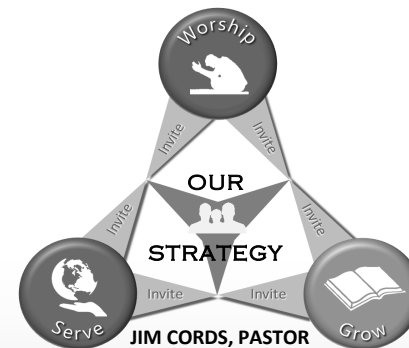

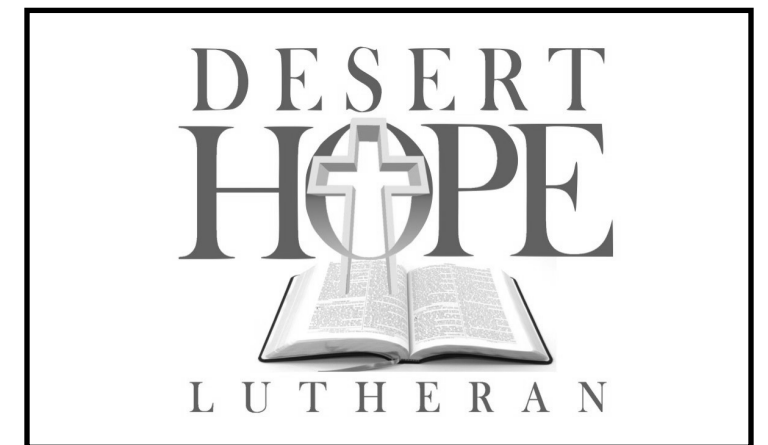

LEAP DAY MEAL PACKING FOR HAITI

Through our meal packing events in 2017 and 2018 we sent about 50,000 meals to Haiti. In 2019, we sent another 35,000 meals. On Saturday, February 29, 9am, we plan to pack and send 35,000 more meals. We need to raise another \$3,000 to cover the cost of the meals. *If we can raise another \$1,500 (\$4,500 total) we will be able to send 40,000 meals to Haiti in 2020.*

Can you help us send even more meals to Haiti in 2020? Each meal costs just 30 cents and for most of these children it is their only nutritional food source they receive each day. Any amount will help make a difference in the lives of these children.
