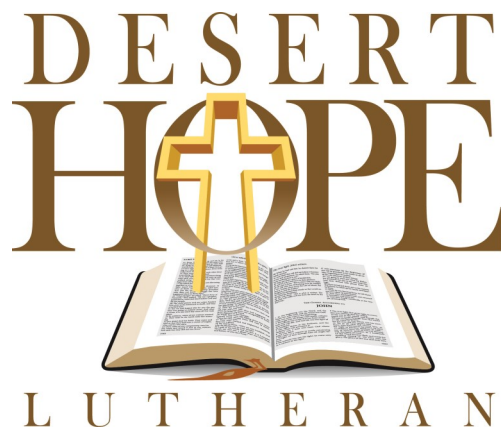

The patterns are not difficult, and can be accomplished with any level of sewing skills.

My hope is that all of you are wearing masks when you are in a community setting, ie: grocery store, pharmacy, etc. This is in addition to social distancing – keeping a distance of at least 6 feet from another person. The CDC advises the use of cloth face coverings to slow the spread of the virus and to help people who may have the virus and do not know it from transmitting it to others.
