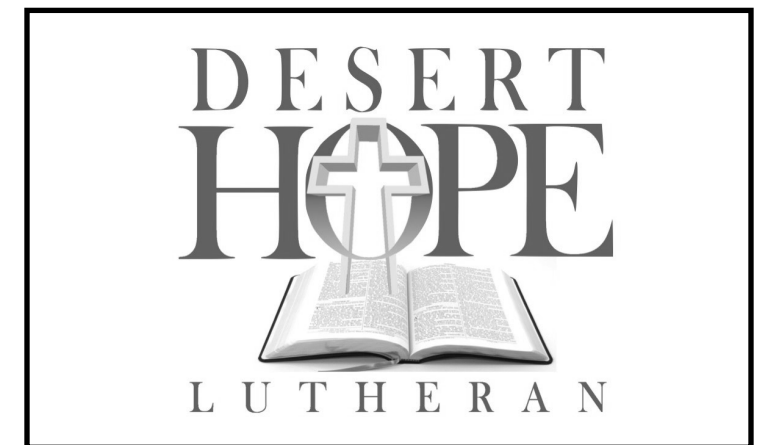

Desert Hope is blessed with partners who help us make a difference in the lives we touch through our ministries and outreach programs. One of these partners is Thrivent Financial Services. Through their Action Team grants, Thrivent has helped offset costs associated with our holiday food baskets for the less fortunate, the packing of meals for Haiti's poor, the Agua Prieta shelter construction teams and Vacation Bible School.
