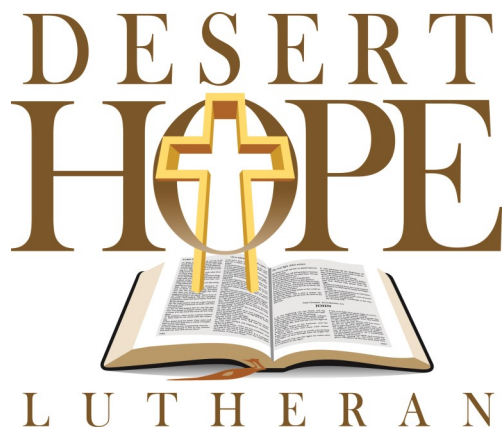

WORSHIP AT DESERT HOPE

INFORMATION FORUM AND ANNUAL MEETING OF THE CONGREGATION

Sunday February 6, 10:45am, Information Forum

Sunday, February 6, following the worship service, there will be an **Information Forum**. You will have the opportunity to see the 2021 Financial Reports, the proposed 2022 Operating Budget, be introduced to the Leadership Council nominees for 2022 and get a closer look at the Governance Review Team scope. We encourage you to participate and ask questions at that time relating to the 2022 Leadership Council election and the 2022 Operating Budget to be voted on at the Meeting of the Congregation on Sunday, February 13, in-person or via Zoom.

Sunday, February 13, 10:45am, Annual Meeting of the Congregation

Sunday, February 13, following the worship service, we will hold our **Annual Meeting of the Congregation**. At this meeting you will be asked to approve the 2021 Financial Reports, adopt the 2022 Operating Budget, vote on Leadership Council nominations, and hear the President's Report.

PASTORAL SUPPLY UPDATE

Pastor Dave Drum has agreed to support us at 40% of a full-time position, or two days per week. One of those days is Sunday. The other one will vary as he continues to run J17 Ministries and has weekly commitments there. He is also attending Executive Committee and Leadership Council meetings and assisting with pastoral care calls. If you would like to meet with Pastor Drum, contact the church office, 722-9134.

Desert Hope will be calling an intentional interim pastor. An intentional interim pastor is one who has been trained specifically to help congregations through transitions. As opposed to an interim pastor, who is merely a "placeholder" until a new pastor is called, an intentional interim pastor is one who can help identify and work through the various dynamics involved with pastoral change. An intentional interim pastor can be very useful after a long pastorate, as well as after a very short pastorate. Desert Hope has experienced both in a relatively short period of time. The Desert Hope Leadership Team will be beginning the process of identifying an intentional interim pastor.

The expectation is that an intentional interim pastor would be in place for at least one year and possibly up to two years. A Transition Committee from the congregation would work closely with the intentional interim pastor during their time with us.

HOLY COMMUNION:

Holy Communion is for those who trust in Jesus and believe He brings the grace He promises in this Holy Meal.

For in-person worship we are using prepackaged communion kits that contain a wafer and grape juice sealed in a cup. You will pick up the kit from the large table in the Narthex. Following the Words of Institution and the Lord's Prayer, you will lift your mask away from your mouth; and we will all take communion together while everyone stays in their seats. Afterwards, please replace your mask over your nose and mouth. There are bowls at each exit in the back of the sanctuary for empty kits.

If you are worshipping at home, gather wine or grape juice and bread and take communion during the same time.
