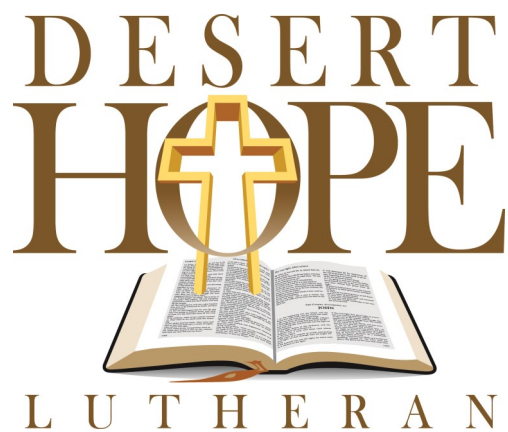

WORSHIP AT DESERT HOPE

Worship in-person is on Sunday at 9:30am. **Masks are required.**

Communion will be where you are seated and with prepackaged communion kits that contain a wafer and grape juice sealed in a cup. You will pick up the kit from the large table in the Narthex. The service will be live streamed, <https://www.youtube.com/user/DesertHopeTucson>.

Sunday School is at 9:30am. The Nursery is not staffed but is available to parents as a Cry Room.

UPDATE ON MASKS AND COMMUNION AT DESERT HOPE

The Pima County Board of Supervisors met earlier this month and voted to let the mask mandate expire on Monday, February 28. Effective Tuesday, March 1, masks will not be required to be worn inside our buildings. However, individuals may, and are encouraged to, wear masks if they so choose.

We will return to in-person Communion beginning with Ash Wednesday services on Wednesday, March 2. For those not comfortable with in-person Communion, the individual Communion sets will still be available so you can take Communion from your seat.

- Midweek Lenten Worship at Desert Hope will be on Wednesdays, March 9-April 6 at 7pm.

Lenten Worship will include the beautiful Holden Evening prayer and hearing one another testify to God's goodness.

FRIDAY WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY

HOLY COMMUNION:

Holy Communion is for those who trust in Jesus and believe He brings the grace He promises in this Holy Meal.

For in-person worship we are using prepackaged communion kits that contain a wafer and grape juice sealed in a cup. You will pick up the kit from the large table in the Narthex. Following the Words of Institution and the Lord's Prayer, you will lift your mask away from your mouth; and we will all take communion together while everyone stays in their seats. Afterwards, please replace your mask over your nose and mouth. There are bowls at each exit in the back of the sanctuary for empty kits.

If you are worshipping at home, gather wine or grape juice and bread and take communion during the same time.
