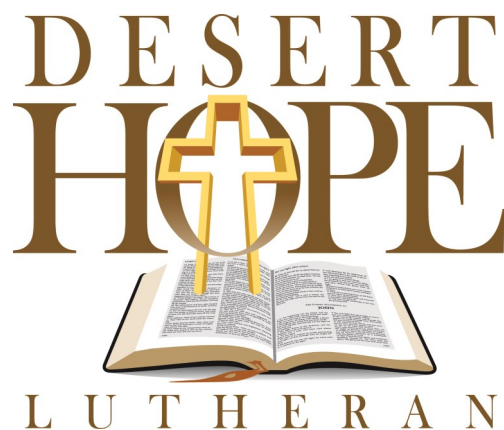

On **Saturday, April 30, 8am to 4pm**, you are invited to a Lutheran Congregations in Ministry for Christ (LCMC) Conflict Resolution Workshop at Desert Hope. The workshop is designed to help you learn about yourself in conflict as well as steps to forgiveness and reconciliation from a Biblical perspective. You will be given tools to help work through conflict in a positive way. The workshop is offered by Perry Fruhling, Coordinator for Pastoral Ministry for LCMC. He has a variety of training from numerous resources in the field of conflict management.

Conflict is as old as the first relationships in the Bible: Adam blamed Eve after their fall from grace in the garden of Eden, then Cain killed in a jealous rage. The Bible describes conflicts between David and Saul, Paul and Barnabas, Peter and Paul, and more. Each of us face conflict in various settings including our churches. The question isn't "if," but "when" conflict will happen within our congregations and how we will choose to deal with it.

We invite everyone to come and learn how to walk together so we can bring strength to our community of faith and become more effective in ministry. **You will need to sign up for the workshop so we have an accurate count for lunch.** Sign-up sheets are available in the Narthex. From Jim Kress, Leadership Council President...

Did you know, at any point in time, 40% of all congregations experience conflict that disrupts mission? Yet, most of us want to avoid it.

Unresolved conflict results in a myriad of people leaving marriages, places of work, families, friendships, AND CHURCHES every year. People become discouraged and live in despair when we avoid conflict.

There is good news! God has given us his Word and tools to resolve conflict that can restore hope and bring reconciliation and forgiveness. Pastor Perry Fruhling, Coordinator for LCMC, has developed a Workshop to develop these tools.

Your Church Council has invited Pastor Fruhling to hold this Conflict Resolution Workshop at Desert Hope Lutheran Church, Saturday, April 30.

The training will consist of understanding conflict from a systems perspective, learning to identify sources of anxiety in congregational conflict, and developing skills in the conflict resolution process.

Desert Hope plans to form a congregational conflict team that will be trained to see the larger picture of a system at work instead of the usual blame game that results in most conflicts. A Conflict Team becomes skilled at helping conflicted parties in the congregation identify resolutions that are mutually satisfactory to all parties involved in a conflict. The key is to help participants in a conflict see each other as humans – God created and redeemed – to gain a heart of peace towards one another and seek solutions together that can bring help and hope.
