

Agua Prieta Family Shelters is dedicated to providing housing for families living in extremely poor conditions in Agua Prieta, Sonora, Mexico. You can help with donations and/or your time.

A group of Desert Hope members and friends travel to Agua Prieta to help build these shelters. The trips include an overnight in Mexico. Safe, comfortable lodging and meals for purchase are provided. A current passport is needed.

Sunday School Assistants are needed. Each week a teacher and an assistant are needed.


Desert Hope's Children's Ministry provides interactive educational opportunities for children Kindergarten through 5th grade during the 9:30am worship service following the Kids Talk.
