





SOAPing.

- <u>Scripture</u>—Open your Bible to the reading found under today's date on your Bible bookmark. Look for a verse that particularly speaks to you, and write it in your journal.
- Observation—What do you see happening in the text? What is the main message or situation? Write this in your journal.
- Application—Ask yourself how it applies to your life right now. Write how this scripture can apply to you.
- **Prayer**—Ask God to help you use this scripture. Now, write your prayer in your journal.

Many of us have found this to be a joyous task, and it has made a noticeable difference in our lives individually and as a community of faith.
