

Worship in-person is on <u>Sunday at 9:30am</u>. The service will be live streamed, https://www.youtube.com/user/DesertHopeTucson.




MOTHER'S DAY

Volunteers needed!!! We need you!


- Be a packer at one or both shifts on Saturday.
