

NUMANA 2023 AT DESERT HOPE

Matthew 25:34-35 Then the King will say to those on His right, Come, you who are blessed by My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for y ou from the foundation of the world. For I was hungry and you gave Me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave Me something to drink, I was a stranger and you took Me in.

Over the years Desert Hope has heard and acted on that call from our Lord Jesus and has served the poor, the hungry and the needy in Tucson and beyond our city borders.

This past year DHLC set a time to provide meals for the more than 1.5 million who live below the poverty level in El Salvador. Saturday, April 29 was set as the date when we would come together and pack meals that would be shipped to our neighbors in Central America.

Your prayers for a successful event were answered. Praise God as He led people to prepare for and participate in providing approximately 47,000 meals, well past our goal of 45,000. We packed 218 boxes, each containing 216 meals. We surpassed our goal because Desert Hope came together as a church and invited our families, friends, neighbors, and others to join us. We are also close to our funding goal; just \$2000 more is needed.

It was my privilege to work along with you in this mission. Desert Hope is truly blessed to have Pastor Kent who believed in and championed this event upon his arrival.

I can't begin to tell you about the devotion of the gentlemen on the Facilities Team, captained by Bob Martin. The Tech and Worship Teams stepped up often at the last minute. A big shout out to Brenda McDowell, Joy Karr, and Dell Hammond who made our event their ongoing priority. Thank you to all who made donations above and beyond your tithes. Most importantly, thank you church, for showing up with eager smiles and steadfast hands and feet! I know some of you rearranged your lives in order to be with us, and your commitment to this cause pleases our good God. During this journey many of you encouraged me with your thoughts, prayers and hugs and I am humbled to be so blessed.

This past Saturday was a time of fellowship, fun and purpose. How awesome is it to come together and reflect our faith by serving people in need.
