Hebrews itself does not tell us who the author is. Martin Luther and many scholars today think that it might have been written by Barnabus. It might have been written to Christians in Rome around 60 AD.

JESUS IS SUPERIOR

1. Jesus is greater than the angels.

"[Jesus] became as much superior to the angels as the name he has inherited is superior to theirs." Hebrews 1:4

2. Jesus is greater than Moses.

"Jesus has been found worthy of greater honor than Moses." Hebrews 3:3
