A. In Germany – Late 17th and early 18th centuries (Arndt, Spener, and Franke)

B. In Scandinavia – around 1800 (Hans Hauge)

1st Great Awakening in US and England 1720-1740 (George Whitefield/ Wesleys)

2nd Great Awakening (Finney) – 1795-1835

Welsh Revival – started in 1904 – early 20th
Century (Evan Roberts)

Azusa Street LA – early 20th century (Bartleman)

Charismatic Renewal – early 20th century

Billy Graham - 1950 to today

- + True repentance
- + Miracles and healings
- + Increase in prayer
- + Fresh love of worship
- + Thirst for Scripture
- + Opposition from religious leaders
- + Interdenominational
