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If people have a genuine, living faith, they will bear fruit.

"Bear fruits worthy of repentance."

Matthew 3:8

1. They will avoid sinful behavior:

"The acts of the flesh are obvious; sexual immorality, impurity... idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition...envy, drunkenness...I warn you...that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God."

Gal. 5:19-21

When we fail and fall into these ungodly acts, godly believers will have a strong allergic reaction. This is the conviction of sin.

The Spirit "will convict the world concerning sin."

John 16:8

We need to repent when we have that conviction.

- + Meet with God's people
- + Pursue holiness

How can a believer bear greater fruit?
