

DESERT HOPE TOGETHER AGAIN

Desert Hope is coming together again! We will be holding two services to keep our gathering to a maximum of 50 persons. Services will be held on <u>Saturday, May 30 at 5pm and Sunday, May 31 at 9:30am</u>. We are encouraging anyone who is not comfortable in coming to a gathering yet, or who is in the high-risk group, to continue to worship with us online. The 9:30am service will be live streamed.

To enable us to open and increase everyone's comfort, the Desert Hope Leadership Council has passed the following guidelines:

- We are asking everyone over 2 years old to wear a mask. Please bring yours from home. If you need one, contact the church office.
- If you are not able to wear a mask, there will be limited seating on the patio with a TV set up to view the service.
- Ushers and greeters will be at the doors to offer hand sanitizer. They will also open and close doors for you to limit the number of surfaces that anyone needs to touch.
- You will be directed to enter the sanctuary through the center doors.
- To maintain the recommended social distancing of 6 feet, every other row of chairs will be removed from the sanctuary. Family members may sit in a group, but groups are asked to keep two chairs between themselves and the next group.
- Hope Notes will continue to be offered only online.

- Communion will not be offered at this time.
- The Offering Plate will be at the back of the sanctuary rather than being passed from person to person.
- When service is over, exit through the two outer doors at the back of the sanctuary. Back rows will exit first.
- Restrooms are limited to two people at a time. Use the automatic door opener (push the button with your hip or elbow) to enter and exit the bathroom. Remember the 20 second rule while washing your hands and use a paper towel to shut off the faucet. If your child needs to use the bathroom, please accompany them.
- Children's Ministry will not be resuming for a while. This means the nursery will not be open and Sunday School will not meet. Please have your children join you for the service in the sanctuary.

We know that we will all be very excited to see each other again! This is a time, however, of thinking of our neighbor first. It is still very important that we continue to practice social distancing. Be creative in showing your joy at being together again – use the American sign language sign for 'I love you', tap your heart or virtually hug.
