

DESERT HOPE TRANSITION UPDATE

A Transition Team has been assembled to evaluate consultant options in creating a churchwide assessment. This will help us evaluate strengths and weaknesses in order to develop a church profile and is essential groundwork in preparation for a Call Committee.

As this team comes together, pray that they will have God's guidance and wisdom.

Leadership encourages you to welcome Pastor Steve Bergeson on <u>Saturday, October 3 &</u> <u>Sunday, October 4</u>, as he comes to minister God's word to us. Pastor Steve served as lead pastor at Shepherd of the Hills Lutheran Church in Fountain Hills, AZ for many years, before retiring in 2019.

PRECAUTIONS FOR IN-PERSON WORSHIP

We continue to follow these precautions for in-person worship:

- On arrival, all persons undergo a touchless temperature scan and an application of hand sanitizer.
- Everyone is wearing a mask to cover their nose and mouth throughout the service. Those unable to do this are not attending this service.
- Ushers are available to assist in finding seats with respect to our social distancing measure, two empty seats between family/single groups. Everyone not in a family group is adhering to a 6-foot social distance and no physical contact.
- Outside, sanctuary and main bathroom doors are open for entry and exit to avoid touching of common doors and handles.
- We ask that all persons adhere to the 20 second handwashing guidelines. Parents/guardians are monitoring their children in those situations.
- The facility will be cleaned by volunteers immediately after conclusion of the Saturday service. We ask everyone to exit promptly to facilitate and expedite this process for the next morning's service.
- The nursery is currently closed due to COVID-19 concerns. However, the child-sized toilet in that room is available if it is more convenient for a toddler.



HOLY COMMUNION:

Holy Communion is for those who trust in Jesus and believe He brings the grace He promises in this Holy Meal. We are grateful that we have found a way to safely have communion together in-person and online.

For in-person worship we are using prepackaged communion kits that contain a wafer and grape juice sealed in a cup. You will pick up the kit from the large table in the Narthex immediately after you sanitize your hands when you arrive. Following the Words of Institution and the Lord's Prayer, you will lift your mask away from your mouth; and we will all take communion together while everyone stays in their seats. Afterwards, please replace your mask over your nose and mouth. The ushers will come by to pick up the used cups and sanitize your hands. If you are worshipping at home, gather wine or grape juice and bread and take communion during the same time.
