

#### **NEW WORSHIP TIMES STARTING THIS SUNDAY NOVEMBER 8**

Worship will now be on <u>Sundays at 8:30am & 10:30am</u>. **There will not be a Saturday service.** Both services will be in-person and the 8:30am service will be live streamed. *Nursery will be open during the 10:30 service only*.

To ensure that there are sanitary seats for everyone, every other row of chairs in the sanctuary is ribboned off. Please sit in the open rows only. At the conclusion of the 8:30 service, the ribbons will be moved to the alternate rows to provide "clean" seats for the 10:30 worshippers. At the conclusion of the 10:30 service the entire sanctuary will be thoroughly sanitized.




#### 2021 PLEDGE CARDS AND COMMITMENT SUNDAY

#### THANK YOU FOR YOUR RESPONSE TO THE SURVEY

Thank you for the 182 responses to the congregational survey from Church Doctor Ministries. Our goal was 85 so this response is terrific! You certainly blew way past our goal and showed your interest and support in our Pastoral Transition. Church Doctor representative and founder, Kent Hunter, will be here starting November 29. He will conduct in-person interviews of leadership and others to sharpen the focus and add additional depth to the church health assessment.

## **HOLY COMMUNION:**

Holy Communion is for those who trust in Jesus and believe He brings the grace He promises in this Holy Meal. We are grateful that we have found a way to safely have communion together in-person and online.

For in-person worship we are using prepackaged communion kits that contain a wafer and grape juice sealed in a cup. You will pick up the kit from the large table in the Narthex immediately after you sanitize your hands when you arrive. Following the Words of Institution and the Lord's Prayer, you will lift your mask away from your mouth; and we will all take communion together while everyone stays in their seats. Afterwards, please replace your mask over your nose and mouth. The ushers will come by to pick up the used cups and sanitize your hands. If you are worshipping at home, gather wine or grape juice and bread and take communion during the same time.
