

WORSHIP AT DESERT HOPE

Worship in-person is on Sunday at 8:30am & 10:30am. The 10:30am service will be live streamed.

To ensure that there are sanitary seats for everyone at each worship service, every other row of chairs in the sanctuary is ribboned off. Please sit in the open rows only. At the conclusion of the 8:30 service, the ribbons will be moved to the alternate rows to provide "clean" seats for the 10:30 worshippers. At the conclusion of the 10:30 service the entire sanctuary will be thoroughly sanitized.

The Nursery at Desert Hope will not be available due to COVID-19 concerns. You may use the toddler-sized toilet or baby changing area in the nursery at any time, but you are unable to use the nursery as a cry room.



INTERIM PASTOR APPOINTED

The Pastoral Transition Team recommended to the Leadership Council that we extend a six-month contract to Pastor Steve Bergeson to serve as the Interim Pastor for Desert Hope. The council approved this appointment and Pastor Steve has accepted. Beginning January 1, he will begin serving in this capacity through June, 2021.

A worship service to install Pastor Steve in this new role will be held at Desert Hope on <u>Sunday, January 3, 10:30am</u>. *This will be the ONLY worship service held on that day.* Pastor Dave Drum will be the presiding pastor at this special service. The service will be livestreamed.

HOLY COMMUNION:

Holy Communion is for those who trust in Jesus and believe He brings the grace He promises in this Holy Meal. We are grateful that we have found a way to safely have communion together in-person and online.

For in-person worship we are using prepackaged communion kits that contain a wafer and grape juice sealed in a cup. You will pick up the kit from the large table in the Narthex immediately after you sanitize your hands when you arrive. Following the Words of Institution and the Lord's Prayer, you will lift your mask away from your mouth; and we will all take communion together while everyone stays in their seats. Afterwards, please replace your mask over your nose and mouth. The ushers will come by to pick up the used cups and sanitize your hands. If you are worshipping at home, gather wine or grape juice and bread and take communion during the same time.
