

BIBLE READING PLAN FOR 2021

The Daily Bible Reading Plan for this year is *The Bible in ONE Year Reading Plan* designed by Christ's Church of the Valley. This plan reads through the entire Bible in one year. Each weekday you will be provided with readings from the New Testament, Old Testament and Psalms or Proverbs. Since the beginning of Desert Hope, as a congregation we have been

involved with a daily Bible reading plan and **SOAP**.

- <u>Scripture</u>—Open your Bible to the reading found under today's date on your Bible bookmark. Look for a verse that particularly speaks to you, and write it in your journal.
- <u>Observation</u>—What do you see happening in the text? Using your own words, write the main idea in your journal.
- <u>Application</u>—Ask yourself how it applies to your life right now. Write how this scripture can apply to you.
- <u>Prayer</u>—This can be as simple as asking God to help you use this scripture, or it may be a greater insight on what He may be revealing to you. Now, write your prayer in your journal.

If you have not begun this reading plan, It is never to late to start. *Bookmarks are available in the Narthex and were sent by email*.

CALL TEAM UPDATE

The Call Team has completed their initial training with Church Doctor Ministries and has been developing various documents about the position and Desert Hope to send to qualified candidates. This includes the Position Posting, Lead Pastor Position Description, and Desert Hope's Philosophy of Ministry. The team has developed procedures to administer and conduct the lengthy process of evaluating and interviewing candidates. We expect to formally post the position with LCMC and other appropriate websites by Thursday, February 4.

Church Doctor has been a great resource in helping the Call Team develop our call process as LCMC does not have the capability of assisting us beyond posting the position.

HOLY COMMUNION:

Holy Communion is for those who trust in Jesus and believe He brings the grace He promises in this Holy Meal. We are grateful that we have found a way to safely have communion together in-person and online.

For in-person worship we are using prepackaged communion kits that contain a wafer and grape juice sealed in a cup. You will pick up the kit from the large table in the Narthex immediately after you sanitize your hands when you arrive. Following the Words of Institution and the Lord's Prayer, you will lift your mask away from your mouth; and we will all take communion together while everyone stays in their seats. Afterwards, please replace your mask over your nose and mouth. The ushers will come by to pick up the used cups and sanitize your hands. If you are worshipping at home, gather wine or grape juice and bread and take communion during the same time.
