

HOLY COMMUNION:

Holy Communion is for those who trust in Jesus and believe He brings the grace He promises in this Holy Meal. We are grateful that we have found a way to safely have communion together in-person and online.

For in-person worship we are using prepackaged communion kits that contain a wafer and grape juice sealed in a cup. You will pick up the kit from the large table in the Narthex immediately after you sanitize your hands when you arrive. Following the Words of Institution and the Lord's Prayer, you will lift your mask away from your mouth; and we will all take communion together while everyone stays in their seats. Afterwards, please replace your mask over your nose and mouth. The ushers will come by to pick up the used cups and sanitize your hands. If you are worshipping at home, gather wine or grape juice and bread and take communion during the same time.

ONLINE VOTING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) A congregation-wide email will be sent out containing the Special Congregational meeting Zoom link.
- 2) You must click on the Zoom link provided in that email to login into the meeting. Login begins at 11:30am, but you must be logged in no later than 11:55am.
 - a) Everyone is encouraged to login to the meeting on his/her own device (computer/tablet/smartphone)
- 3) Attendance will be taken.
 - a) Only voting members of the church are allowed to vote on the motion.
 - b) The attendance rosters used for in-person attendance at the meeting reflect this voting status.
 - c) Those members attending via Zoom will be marked present on the in-person attendance rosters by the Zoom host as the Zoom attendees login.
- 4) The Zoom meeting will be locked at 11:55am by the Zoom host. No more people/devices will be allowed to login. The Zoom host will then set all Zoom votes to be marked as ANONYMOUS as they occur, protecting each voter's privacy.
- 5) 5) When it is time to vote on the motion to call the candidate for Lead Pastor of DHLC, a separate window will pop-up on your screen with the voting choices.
 - a) Lone voters on Zoom.
 - i) 3 ballot choices. You may choose only one answer by clicking on it.
 - (1) Yes, I support extending a call to Brian McGee as Lead Pastor of Desert Hope Lutheran Church.
 - (2) No, I oppose extending a call to Brian McGee as Lead Pastor of Desert Hope Lutheran Church.
 - (3) I cannot, at this time, either support or oppose extending a call to Brian McGee as Lead Pastor of Desert Hope Lutheran Church.
 - b) Couples voting via Zoom with only one logged in device.
 - i) Zoom sees the logged in device (computer/tablet/smartphone) as one person.
 - (1) One person gets one vote.
 - ii) If a couple attends the meeting, but has one device, Zoom can only record one vote. This issue is addressed by the following procedure:
 - (1) When logging into the meeting, the couple will advise the Zoom host that there are two members attending.
 - (2) The Zoom host will mark the two members as being present.
 - (3) There will be six ballot choices for the two members to choose from.
 - iii) 6 ballot choices. You may choose only one answer by clicking on it.
 - (1) Both members vote Yes, I support extending a call to Brian McGee as Lead Pastor of Desert Hope Lutheran Church.
 - (2) Both members vote No, I oppose extending a call to Brian McGee as Lead Pastor of Desert Hope Lutheran Church.
 - (3) Both members vote I cannot, at this time, either support or oppose extending a call to Brian McGee as Lead Pastor of Desert Hope Lutheran Church.
 - (4) 1 member votes Yes, I support extending a call to Brian McGee as Lead Pastor of Desert Hope Lutheran Church; 1 member votes No, I oppose extending a call to Brian McGee as Lead Pastor of Desert Hope Lutheran Church.
 - (5) 1 member votes Yes, I support extending a call to Brian McGee as Lead Pastor of Desert Hope Lutheran Church; 1 member votes I cannot, at this time, either support or oppose extending a call to Brian McGee as Lead Pastor of Desert Hope Lutheran Church.
 - (6) 1 member votes No, I oppose extending a call to Brian McGee as Lead Pastor of Desert Hope Lutheran Church; 1 member votes I cannot, at this time, either support or oppose extending a call to Brian McGee as Lead Pastor of Desert Hope Lutheran Church.

The results (# of votes per choice) will show only to the Zoom host who will then share them with the ballot tellers in the sanctuary, to be added to the in-person ballots cast.
